The best time to see **Hachisuka** cherry blossoms is from late February to early March.

Late March to early April is the best time to see **Somei Yoshino** and **weeping** cherry blossoms.

徳島中央公園(Tokushima Central Park)

[Number of trees] About 250 trees

[Location] Along the Suketo River, Tokushima-cho, Tokushima City

[Best time to see] Mid-February to early March

Hachisuka cherry blossoms, a species of cherry tree endemic to Tokushima Prefecture, bloom in glory near the ruins of the castle of Lord Hachisuka, the lord of the Awa domain. The rows of cherry trees with their vibrant deep pink petals are at their best in early to mid-March. You can also take the "Hyotanjima Cruise" to view the cherry blossoms from the river.

[Number of trees] About 250 trees

[Location] Tokushima-cho Castle, Tokushima City

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

[Lighting up] 18:00 to 22:00

One of Tokushima's most famous cherry blossom viewing spots, the ruins of the castle of Lord Hachisuka, the lord of the Awa domain, are bustling with visitors when the cherry blossoms are in full bloom. Somei-yoshino and double-flowered cherry blossoms bloom, and at night the area is lit up, creating a fantastic atmosphere. The sight of cherry blossom petals falling on the surface of the outer moat is a spectacular sight.

眉山公園(Bizan Park)

[Number of trees] About 1,500 trees

[Location] Bizan-cho, Tokushima City

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

[Illuminated] Sunset to 22:00

One of the most popular tourist spots in the prefecture, offering a panoramic view of Tokushima city. The view from the summit of Mt. Bizan is beautiful both during the day and at night, and the night view in particular is a popular spot throughout the country. The cherry blossoms reach their best viewing time around late March every year, and in addition to enjoying the cherry blossoms while driving along Bizan Parkway, viewing the cherry blossoms from the Bizan Ropeway is also popular.



🌸 西部公園(Seibu Park)

East

[Number of trees] About 500 trees

[Location] Kamona-cho, Tokushima City

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

[Lighting up] sunset to 22:00

Seibu Park, located halfway up Mt. Bizan, next to Kuramoto Park, is also a popular cherry blossom viewing spot.



🌸 花見山(Hanamiyama)

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- [Number of trees] About 400 weeping cherries
[Location] Naruto-cho, Naruto City
[Best time to see] Late March to early April
[Date and time] 2025/3/27 ~ 4/10 AM9:00~PM4:00
[Admission fee] 300JPY
[Parking fee] Passenger car : free, Bus: 1,000JPY
✕Reservations are required for group use.

Please make a reservation from the application form on the website by March 24th.
It is a famous spot for weeping cherry blossoms with a panoramic view of the Naruto Strait.

生名の桜 (Cherry Blossoms on the Ikuna Roman Kaido Road)

East

[Number of trees] About 300 trees

[Location] Ikuna, Katsuura-cho, Katsuura-gun

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

A row of cherry trees stretches for about 1 km along the Ikuna-dani River, a tributary of the Katsuura River. You can enjoy cherry blossom viewing while strolling, and it is very popular with families and couples.

The "Katsuura Sakura Festival" is held every year from late March to early April, and during the period you can enjoy night cherry blossom illuminations, boat rides, trolleys, and more. (3/25-4/10 in 2024)

In addition, at the nearby "Doll Culture Exchange Center," you can enjoy the "Big Hina Festival," which exhibits 30,000 dolls, from late February to early April (2/24-4/7 in 2024).



❀ 明王寺のしだれ桜 (Weeping cherry blossoms at Myouji Temple) East



[Number of trees] 2 trees (100 and 80 years old)

[Location] Myo-ji Temple, Shimobun Nishidera, Kamiyama Town, Myozai-gun

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

The entire town of Kamiyama is known as a famous spot for weeping cherry trees. The weeping cherry trees at Myo-ji Temple are particularly famous, with two famous trees, one 100 years old and the other 80 years old, blooming magnificently.

🌸 神山森林公園イルローザの森

(Kamiyama Forest Park The Forest of Il Rosa)



[Number of trees] About 3,000 trees

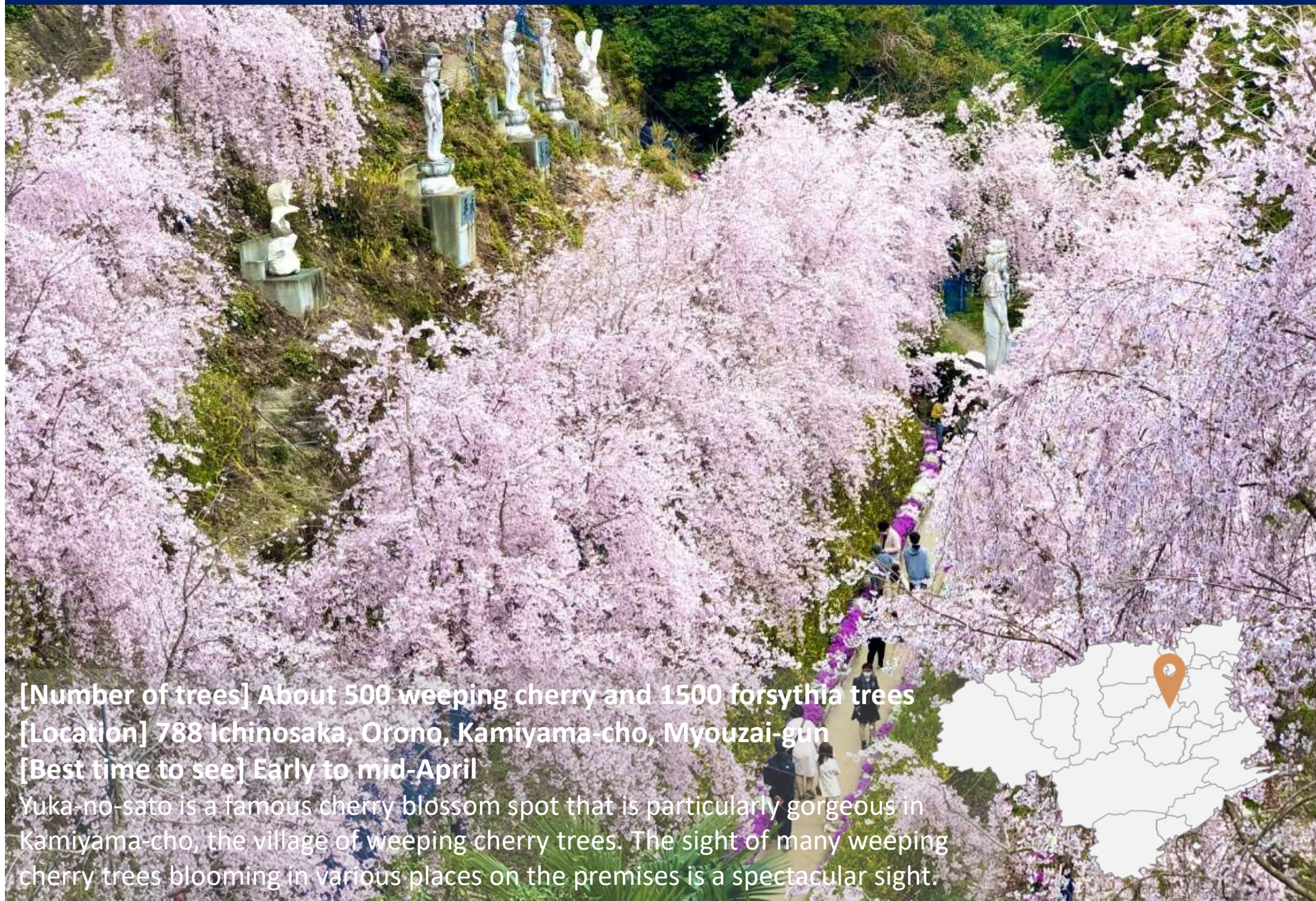
[Location] 459-1 Daichi, Ano, Kamiyama-cho, Myouzai-gun

[Best time to see] Early to mid-April

Kamiyama Forest Park Il Rosa Forest is one of the prefecture's most famous cherry blossom spots, and along the prefectural road to the park, many cherry blossoms are in full bloom, making it look like a cherry blossom tunnel. Pets are allowed in the spacious park.

🌸 ゆうかの里のしだれ桜(Yuka-no-sato)

East



[Number of trees] About 500 weeping cherry and 1500 forsythia trees

[Location] 788 Ichinosaka, Orono, Kamiyama-cho, Myouzai-gun

[Best time to see] Early to mid-April

Yuka-no-sato is a famous cherry blossom spot that is particularly gorgeous in Kamiyama-cho, the village of weeping cherry trees. The sight of many weeping cherry trees blooming in various places on the premises is a spectacular sight.



薬王寺の桜(Yakuohji Temple)

South



[Number of trees] About 300 trees

[Location] 285-1 Teramae, Okukawauchi, Minami-cho, Kaifu-gun

[Lighting up] Late March to early April 18:30 - 22:00

It is especially famous as a cherry blossom spot among the 88 sacred sites of Shikoku, and in spring it is crowded with pilgrims and cherry blossom viewers. At night, the Yugi Tower, which can be said to be the symbol of Yakuohji Temple, is lit up, creating a fantastic atmosphere.

❀ 岩脇公園(Iwawaki Park)

South



[Number of trees] About 1,000 trees

[Location] Iwawaki, Hanoura-cho, Anan City

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

[Light-up] 18:30-21:00

[Events] Boat rentals available (only during the best time to see)

The beautiful cherry blossom tunnel, with its 400m long flower pattern, soothes the hearts of all who visit. Once you pass through the cherry blossom tunnel, the mountains spread out before you, and the deep green accented with pink makes it feel especially vivid.



八百萬神之御殿の桜 (Yaoyorozu no Kami no Goten)

West

Cherry blossom viewing will be closed to the public in 2025.

[Number of trees] About 8,000 trees

[Location] 1701-2 Higashiakatanimyo, Wakimachi, Mima City

[Best time to see] Late March to mid-April (8:00-18:00)

The largest cherry blossom in the prefecture, with about 8,000 carefully maintained Somei Yoshino trees blooming in profusion throughout the year. Located at an altitude of approximately 400m, an admission fee is required. The overwhelming beauty of the blossoms covering the mountainside is overwhelming.



🌸 美濃田の淵 (Minoda no fuchi/An abyss in Minoda) West



[Number] About 150 trees

[Location] Minoda no Fuchi, Ashiro, Higashi Miyoshi-cho, Miyoshi-gun

[Best time to see] Late March to early April

[Lighting up] Late March to early April (to coincide with cherry blossom blooming) 18:00-22:00

Minoda no Fuchi, which is 2km long and 100m wide, is a scenic spot in the middle reaches of the Yoshino River, where beautiful nature changes with the seasons and mysterious strange and bizarre rocks reflect on the clear, deep blue water. There is also a campsite and tennis courts.
