#### Traditional festivals preserve old local traditions.

Each local festival has its own special importance to the locals, so when attending a festival, we suggest speaking to the local people about the festival, so you can fully enjoy the festivities.



#### Ozato Hachiman Shrine Autumn Festival

Kaiyo Town

This is a traditional autumn festival in which seven colorful danjiri and sekibune (floats) run furiously through the Hachiman Shrine in Ozato, Kaiyo Town, raising a cloud of dust with the sound of gongs and drums. On the day before the festival, a fireworks display is held on the banks of the Kaifu River.



#### Mugi Hachiman Shrine Autumn Festival

Mugi Town

A traditional autumn festival in which sekibune, nishiura hanaguruma float, and isami daiko drums parade through the town, sounding gongs and drums at the Hachiman Shrine in Mugi Town.



#### Hiwasa Hachiman Shrine Autumn Festival

Minami Town

The large taiko floats seen at the Hiwasa Hachiman Shrine Autumn Festival are called "chosa". The Chosa is a western Japanese tradition, and is distinctive primarily for the drums that are carried on floats. Each district owns its own "chosa," which is decorated in a unique way.



#### Anan City

#### Tachibana Umisho Hachiman Shrine Autumn Festival

This is a dynamic and valiant festival in which four-ton Danjiris (floats) are ferociously smashed against each other in the streets of Tachibana-cho, Anan City. It is recommended to attend the festival by using public transportation whenever possible.



#### Kaiyo Town

#### Minatobashira Shrine Dedication Akachan-dohyo-Iri, Baby's first step into sumo ring

Baby boys born during the previous year enter the sumo ring in the ring built in Yamashita Park in Tomoura, Kaiyo Town. In this dedication ritual, the babies enter the ring wearing a brightly made-up mawashi (sash) and shiko-names such as tiger and hawk, with the hope that they will grow up to be as strong as sumo wrestlers.



#### Naka Town

#### Kurotakiji Temple Festival


This festival is held at the famous Kurotakiji Temple, known as the inner sanctuary of Tairyuji Temple, the 21st sacred site of the 88 temples of Shikoku. Numerous worshippers come to the festival.



#### Mugi Town

#### Mugi Himegami Festival

This is a traditional event associated with the tragic love story of "Himegami," a peculiar shaped rock on Oshima island in Mugi. The deity, which is shaped like a male symbol, is carried on a fishing boat in a sea parade to Oshima. A fireworks display is held at night.





#### South Tokushima Prefecture

#### Ohenro Pilgrimage Route

The pilgrimage route that visits the 88 sacred sites in Shikoku and is connected to Kukai, is visited by many people. In 2010, the pilgrims' path around the 21st temple, Tairyuji, became a national historic site. Among them, the "Kamo-michi" is described as the path of Kukai's pilgrimage, and is the oldest pilgrimage path in Shikoku with remaining stone structures from the Nanbokucho period. In recent years, many people have walked this road and it has come into the limelight.



#### Yakuoji Temple

Minami Town

Yakuoji Temple is the 23rd and last Shikoku sacred site in Tokushima Prefecture. It is a separate head temple of the Koyasan Shingon sect of Buddhism, and is famous as a place of fundamental prayer to ward off bad luck. It is said that if you climb the stone steps while offering money to each step, you will be healed of any misfortune that may befall you.



#### Byodoji Temple

Anan City

Byodoji Temple was founded by Kobo Daishi Kukai in 814. As the 22nd temple of the Shikoku Sacred Site, it welcomes pilgrims from all over the world, and is known as the Medicine Buddha who equally heals the mental and physical ailments of all people.

#### Tebajima Island

Mugi Town


A small island with the oldest buildings dating back to the end of the Edo period and buildings from the Meiji to the early Showa periods. The fishing village community was selected as a national Important Preservation District for Groups of Traditional Buildings in 2008.



#### Noson Butai Community Stage

South Tokushima Prefecture

Tokushima Prefecture has a large number of rural stages for puppet shows in the southern part of the prefecture, and in recent years a number of rural stages have been revived and performances are held annually.



The southern part of Tokushima Prefecture is full of beautiful nature and scenic sights such as oceans, mountains, and rivers.

#### Mugi Town

#### Hydrangea Road

The town road in Uchizuma, Mugi Town is planted with 4,000 hydrangeas and is called "Ajisai rodo", Hydrangea Road. In mid-June, the "Hydrangea Festival" is held and many people come to take a stroll.



#### Todoroki Falls

Kaiyo Town

One of the 100 best waterfalls in Japan, Todoroki Falls is the largest waterfall in Shikoku. Upstream of the main falls is a series of waterfalls of various sizes, each with its own unique features, collectively known as the 99 Todoroki Falls.



#### Cape Kamoda

Anan City

This is the easternmost cape in Shikoku. It is the first place in Shikoku where the sun rises, and in late autumn and winter, the "Daruma sunrise" can sometimes be viewed. On a clear day, Onaruto Bridge, Awaji Island, and Wakayama Prefecture can be seen from the cape.



#### Namikiri Fudoson

Kaiyo Town

Fudoson, associated with Kobo Daishi, is located upstream from the Haha River, a tributary of the Kaifu River. The moss covering the entire area creates a mysterious atmosphere.

The beautiful Tachibana Bay that can be seen from the temple grounds is truly spectacular! It is especially recommended to visit during the cherry blossom season.












#### Japanese spiny lobster Iseebi

Japanese spiny lobster nurtured by the Kuroshio Current is a delicacy, with a crispy texture and melt-in-your-mouth sweetness! Ise lobster festivals are held in various locations in autumn.



### Daggertooth pike conger (eel)

#### Although it is often associated with summer, hamo in the fall and winter months is fatty and is also called

matsutake hamo or golden hamo.



#### Aioi Awa Bancha tea Naka Town

Lactic acid fermented tea with a unique taste and aroma that is addictive. It is gentle on the stomach and has recently been attracting attention as a health drink.



#### Hangoroshi Mochi Naka Town

Local ohagi delicacy made by pounding glutinous and non-glutinous rice, only half of which is mashed together.



Kancha is hand-picked by local grannies during the coldest season of the year, and has a mild and soft taste.



#### Kito Yuzu and manufactured goods

Kito yuzu has a refreshing aroma and a unique sour taste. In addition to processed products such as ponzu (Japanese citrus fruit vinegar), yuzu pepper, and yuzu miso, recently yuzu sweets have been also introduced to the market.

## Museums in the South Tokushima Area



#### Hiwasa Chelonian Museum Caretta

Minami Town

Hiwasa Chelonian Museum Caretta has a cute "Baby Turtle Tank" for ages 0 to 3, a "Floating Sea Turtle Hall" where rare sea turtles swim, and a "Giant Turtle

Pool", making it one of the few museums in Japan specializing in sea turtles where visitors can encounter many sea turtles. There is also a high-definition video showing spawning behavior and an observatory from which visitors can view the entire Ohama coastline. 370-4 Hiwasaura, Minami, Kaifu District, Tokushima 779-2304





#### Mollusco Mugi

Mugi Town

In addition to the Shell Museum, which houses fossil specimens of shells collected from around the world, visitors can see "Matsugaiso," which has been recognized as one of the 88 most scenic spots on Shikoku Island. The museum is

also equipped with a Wi-Fi environment and can be used as a co-working space.

#### Sea Nature Museum Marine Jam

Kaivo Town

At Marine Jam, visitors can enjoy marine sports such as sea kayaking and SUP, as well as the "Blue Marine," an underwater sightseeing boat that allows visitors to enjoy coral reefs and colorful tropical fish while sitting in the observation deck at the bottom of the

boat. The "Island's Little Aquarium," located within the facility, is an aquarium that can be enjoyed by both children and adults, and is filled with the unique innovations of Marine Jam.

#### Awa Kainan Bunkamura

#### Folk Museum of Awa Kubo

Anan City

This museum introduces the history of successive Awa no Kubo, descendants of the Muromachi Shogun Ashikaga, who resided in Awa Heijima from the late Muromachi Period to the mid-Edo Period Voshiei son of Ashikaga Yoshifuyu, the first lord of Awa

the mid-Edo Period. Yoshiei, son of Ashikaga Yoshifuyu, the first lord of Awa, became the 14th shogun of the Muromachi Shogunate from this place. 
#### Aioi Forest Museum

#### SUP Stand Up Paddling
